## MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

S.8388-A, by Senator Harckham

A.7866-A, by Member of Assembly Zebrowski

The Retired Public Employees Association (RPEA) representing the interests of public sector retirees supports this bill, the Health Equities for Retirees Act, which would prevent a diminution of health insurance benefits for retirees and their dependents below the level in effect as of November 1, 2022.

Public sector employees spend their entire careers providing essential services at all levels of government in the state. They fully anticipate that upon retirement, the benefits in place at the time will remain, and not be diminished. If a lesser benefit were to occur, retirees may see a reduced access to medical care, long pre-authorization procedures, and the need to switch providers. All this would be a detriment to the physical well-being of retirees.

For the reasons stated above, RPEA strongly supports this bill, and recommends that it be passed by the Legislature.
